DRUG WARRANT EXECUTED

Officers from Sutton Central Safer Neighbourhood Team executed a drugs warrant with the assistance of other officers from Sutton. As officers entered the property it is believed the occupants were disturbed whilst preparing the drugs for distribution.

During the search of the property a large quantity of drugs, approximately 101 wraps of cocaine and drug paraphernalia was found along with an offensive weapon. Four arrests were made at the venue and one man has been charged with Possession With Intent to Supply Class A Drugs and possession of Criminal property, as well as being recalled to prison.

SHANKLIN RAIDS

Officers from the Belmont Safer Neighbourhoods team with assistance from other wards executed 3 simultaneous drug warrants across the Shanklin Estate. Officers gained entry to the three venues and detained numerous persons found at each address. During the following searches, numerous items were found including 75 pots containing herbal cannabis, a large bundle of cannabis, a plastic tub containing several large wraps of cannabis, 4 marble size wraps of cocaine, 3 sets of scales and an amount of cash. In total 4 arrests were made in relation to the supply of both Cannabis and Class A drugs.



CARSHALTON HIGH STREET E-SCOOTER OPERATION

Officers from both Carshalton Central and Carshalton South and Clockhouse teams have been out in Carshalton High Street conducting E-Scooter operations. During these operation 7 people have been stopped on scooters and issued with warnings.

KIMPTON INDUSTRIAL ESTATE CAR MEETS

Following complaints from local residents and business owners, North Cluster Officers were out in force to deter any vehicles congregating for meets on the Kimpton Industrial Estate. Several vehicles and groups were stopped and engaged with. This is planned on being an ongoing operation to disrupt and deter these meetings and any criminal behaviour.



CHEAM PARK DRUGS

Officers from the Sutton Safer Parks Team have been continuing patrols throughout the parks and open spaces within the borough. Whilst patrolling Cheam Park they have conducted numerous stops. As a result of these patrols the team has issued two Community Resolutions and four Fixed Penalty Notices for possession of cannabis.

RADCLIFFE GARDENS

Concerns have been raised by local residents in relation to groups of youths congregating in and around the blocks of flats causing Anti Social Behaviour and drugs use. In response, officers from the Carshalton South and Clockhouse ward team have been carrying out patrols of the area. Several groups have been stopped and spoken to.

As a result two (2) people have been issued with Community Resolutions for being in possession of cannabis.

WRYTHE RECREATIONAL GROUND

Officers from the Carshalton Central Safer Neighbourhood Team have been out patrolling the local area. As part of these patrols they have been through The Wrythe Recreational Ground. During these patrols two people have been stopped and found in possession of cannabis. They both received Community Resolutions in relation to the drugs.

KNIFE ARREST

Whilst on patrols officers from the Sutton Central ward team encountered a male who they knew as being a member of a gang who had come to Sutton from another Borough. He was stopped and searched and also taken to Sutton Police Station for a further search. A lock knife was found in his underwear and he was duly arrested for possession of bladed article in a public place. He was recalled to prison due to breaching his licensing conditions concerning Class A drug-dealing.



ROUNDSHAW RHYMETIME

PCSO Thompson from the Beddington South ward team joined children aged 0-5 for songs and stories at Roundshaw Park. Everyone who attended had a good time, including PCSO Thompson.



OAKS PARK PATROLS

Officers from the Sutton Safer Parks Team continue to pay attention to Oaks Park following reports of drugs Use. There have been numerous stops and one male has been issued with a Community resolution for possession of cannabis.

CARSHALTON HIGH STREET DRUGS

The Carshalton Central team have been paying extra attention to the car park in Carshalton High Street, following concerns raised about possible drug use and drug dealing at the location. The team targeted the area during the prime times that residents believed it to be happening. On one such of these patrols the team stopped and searched a male with his vehicle. Officers found a quantity of cocaine in the vehicle. The male was charged with possession of Class A drugs. This action was taken by police based on information given to police by members of the public.



GROVE PARK DRUGS

Carshalton Central ward officers have been listening to the concerns of local residents and park users in relation to Grove Park. They have received complaints of drug usage around the play area within the park. As a result high visibility patrols have been conducted. Several stops have taken place and one male was found in possession of cannabis, for which he was issued a Community Resolution.

COMMUNITY PROTECTION WARNINGS CARSHALTON PONDS

The Carshalton Central Ward Team have received numerous complaints and concerns from local residents and business owners in relation to Antisocial behaviour around the War Memorial, Grove Park and Carshalton High Street from street drinkers. In response to these complaints the team has been out engaging with the street drinkers and members of the public. Officers are currently collating evidence in relation to this behaviour and have currently issued four Community Protection Warnings to various street drinkers. This is the first stage of a problem solving strategy. Should the individuals breach the warning, they can then be issued with a Community Protection Notice, which could give officers a power of arrest and allow individuals to be put before a court in relation to any Anti Social Behaviour.

DANGEROUS VEHICLES

Sutton Safer Parks officers have been patrolling Overton Park. On one such occasion they stopped a male acting suspiciously. Whilst engaging with the male they conducted a drugs search. He was found in possession of cannabis and issued a Fixed Penalty Ticket.



THE MOUNT

Officers from the Carshalton South and Clockhouse Safer Neighbourhoods Team were conducting patrols in The Mount, when they stopped a vehicle. During the stop they identified that the driver did not have any insurance or even a driving licence. The driver was reported for driving without a licence, without insurance and for not wearing a seatbelt.



POSITIVE STOP & SEARCH.

Officers from the Nonsuch ward team were out on patrol in Cuddington Recreational Ground. Officers stopped a male, who was found to be in possession of cannabis. The Cannabis was seized and the male was given a Community Resolution.

GBH ARREST



Officers from the Carshalton Central and Carshalton South SNT were out on patrol when they responded to an emergency call at an address. The call was in relation to a believed domestic situation. Upon arrival officers noticed injuries to the female at the address. Although the female accounted for these injuries the officers were not convinced and continued to ask questions and look around. Several other officers arrived to assist with the situation. During the investigation at the address a quantity of drugs were found along with a large 'zombie' knife. The male was arrested for possession with intent to supply cannabis, possession of an offensive weapon and domestic related GBH. The female was also arrested in relation to the drugs. Due to concerns for children at the venue officers also ensured that they were taken to a place of safety and their ongoing welfare is monitored. Several matters are still under investigation, but the male has been charged with Controlling and Coercive Behaviour, GBH and malicious Communications.

STOLEN VEHICLE RECOVERED

Whilst on patrol officers from the Worcester Park team received reports of an abandoned motor bike located in the Worcester Park area. Officers found the bike and after conducting checks discovered it was on false number plates. The identification numbers had been hidden and the bike was reported as stolen. Officers managed to contact the owner and restore it.

PROACTIVE STOPS CORRIGON REC

Officers from the Carshalton South and Clockhouse Ward Team have been popping into Corrigan Recreational Ground and recently stopped a male. He was searched for drugs and found in possession of cannabis.

FRAUD ARREST

Whilst on patrol officers from the Sutton Safer parks Team has reason to stop a vehicle. Whilst speaking to the occupants, officers suspicions were raised and they were subject to a search.

A bank card was found and in neither of the occupants names. Whilst at the scene officers made some enquiries. It became apparent that the card was being used for fraudulent reasons. Both persons were arrested for fraud. Searches were conducted at their homes and further evidence was found of multiple count of bank card fraud. The matter is currently being investigated by a specialist team.
