CHEAM PARK

Following continued concerns from park users and resident in relation to anti social behaviour in the park and a report of a male exposing himself, officers from the Sutton Safer Parks Team have continued to patrol the park. During these patrols they have issued one person with a Fixed Penalty Notice for possession of cannabis. Additionally they have stopped two juveniles, who were found in possession of cannabis. These individuals have been interviewed, one has been charged for possession of cannabis and the other has been dealt with out of court by the Youth offending team





KIMPTON PARK CAR MEETS

Following the Summer of 2021, where the Stonecot ward saw a sharp increase in car meets in the Kimpton park industrial Estate. These meets were happening on almost a weekly basis and were causing distress to local residents in regards to the noise and fears for personal safety. As a result, officers from the Stonecot Ward worked in partnership with various organisations including Sutton Council. Measures included innovative technology to disrupt and deter the issue. As a result there have been no car meets throughout Summer 2022.



HADLEY PAGE ROAD

Officers from Sutton's Safer Parks Team stopped a group of 8 young males acting suspiciously in Hadley Page Road following calls of concerns from residents. The group were searched and one was found in possession of cannabis. The male was a juvenile and later interviewed by police, following which he has been referred to the Youth offending Team.

ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR IN MANOR PARK

The Sutton Safer Parks Team have received numerous complaints from park users and local resident in relation to groups of youths in the park causing Anti Social Behaviour and intimidating members of the public. As a result of this, patrols in the area have been increased. The team have stopped and spoken to various people, and on one such occasion a male was subjected to a search and found in possession of cannabis for which he was issued with a Community Resolution.

BURGLARY ARREST

The male that was arrested in April for breach of Criminal Behaviour Order not to cold call by officers from Carshalton South and Clockhouse ward team, pleaded guilty at court and received 6 weeks suspended sentence, 8 weeks Tag Curfew daily between 20:00 and 06:00. They were also ordered to pay victim surcharges of £128 and court costs of £325.

Once he was finished at court he was then arrested at court by the team as he was wanted for multiple distraction burglaries around Sutton and Merton.

The burglary team who are investigating took him to Croydon Magistrates where he was remanded by the Court until his hearing in the New year for the offences.







ROSEHILL PARK WEST

Sutton's Safer Parks Team have been patrolling Rose Hill Park West Following increased concerns raised by the local community in relation to drug use in the area. As a result, numerous people have been stopped and spoken to. On one such occasion a male was stopped and searched under the Misuse of Drugs Act. He was found in possession of cannabis and issued a Fixed Penalty Notice in relation to the offence.

DANGEROUS DOG SEIZURE

Officers from the North West Cluster obtained a dangerous dog seizure warrant from court and successfully executed it on the Stonecot ward. The dog was seized and removed.

The dog had bitten a member of public on the arm causing a significant injury.

The dog is currently awaiting assessment and the investigation continues.

MALE CHARGED

Male attended court for driving whilst disqualified, failing to stop, driving on anything other than a highway and no insurance after he was seen riding a moped on the Roundshaw Downs where there have been repeated vehicle offences. He received 100 hours unpaid work, court charges and victim surcharge of £95. The male was arrested following an intel led Investigation.

COLLINGWOOD REC

During routine patrols officers from Sutton's Safer Parks Team have been visiting Collingwood Recreational Ground. During one of these visits a male was stopped. He was searched under the Misuse of Drugs Act and found in possession of cannabis. He received a Community Resolution in relation to the offence.



STOLEN VEHCILES RECOVERED

The Stonecot ward team has been recovering stolen vehicles. A stolen car was found on Woodstock Rise as well as a stolen moped on Barrington Road.

Additionally the team also recovered another moped on Forest Road. All vehicles have been returned to their lawful owners.

E-SCOOTER FINE

A male has been arrested for assault on police and riding an E-Scooter with no insurance. The male appeared in court where he was found guilty.

As a result he received 6 points on his licence and ordered to pay victim surcharges of £169, fined £422 and £85 court fees.

BEDDINGTON PARK

Officers from Sutton's Safer Parks Team have been continuing to patrol Beddington Park, following concerns of drugs use and a suspicious male approaching lone females. During these patrols, officers have stopped and engaged with numerous people.

As a result they found three people in possession of cannabis. One was issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice and the other two received Community Resolution Notices.

During one of their patrols they also identified the suspicious male and warned him in relation to his behaviour.

An intelligence report was submitted and partnership agencies have been notified .

CUDDINGTON RECREATION GROUND

Due to concerns raised by park users and local residents of anti-social behaviour and drug use in the park, officers from Sutton's Safer Parks Team have been paying regular visits. On one of these visits a male was stopped and searched under the Misuse of Drugs Act. He was found in possession of cannabis and issued a Community resolution issued.

SHOPLIFTER ARRESTED OLDFIELDS

Officers from the Stonceot Ward Team were on patrol when they notice a shoplifter running from the Tesco store on Oldfileds Road. A foot chase ensued and after a short time, the suspect was caught. he was found in possession of three stolen bottles of whiskey. He was dealt with by an out of court disposal and a banning notice from the store.











WOODMANSTERNE PRIMARY SCHOOL

Officers from Sutton's Safer Parks Team responded to a call of persons acting suspiciously within the grounds of the primary school. The team attended and found a group of young people hanging around. The group were searched and one was found in possession of cannabis for which they revived a Community Resolution.

SEARS PARK

Whilst on patrols in Sears park officers from Sutton's Safer Parks Team stopped a male. During the stop the male was found in possession of cannabis and was issued with a Community Resolution.
